
Re: Worker's Compensation

Dear Ms. Givens:

This letter is to request that the Reserve Panel of the committee review the determination to not file formal charges as requested in my complaint. It is my belief, based on my investigation, that you did no investigation whatsoever into my allegations. Certainly allowing the Executive Branch to manipulate the Judicial System is something that the Supreme Court would abhor as it should protect the integrity of the judicial process in workers compensation.

I know for a fact that you did not, to my knowledge, ever contact Judge White or Judge Daniels, the two Affiants who had much more information to give if only asked.
